RESOLUTION NO. SP- 789 -S-97

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DISTRICT DIRECTOR OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC) TO REQUIRE THAT ONLY POLICE OFFICIALS WHO HAVE ORIENTATION ON LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING SQUATTING AND DEMOLITION SHALL BE ASSIGNED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AND MAINTAIN PEACE AND ORDER DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ANY DEMOLITION ORDER.

WHEREAS, there are several laws, rules and regulations governing squatting and demolition, such as Republic Act No. 7279, otherwise known as the "Urban Development and Housing Act of 1992.";

WHEREAS; we, the elected and/or appointed leaders in the government, should instill in the hearts and minds of our police officers that their presence during the enforcement of demolition order is for the purpose of providing security and maintaining peace and order both on the part of the squatters and the members of demolition crew and they should take action when either of the members of the demolition crew or the squatters are violating existing laws;

WHEREAS, there were many instances wherein, in the presence of police officers, demolitions were conducted during weekends, heavy downpour, early in the morning, late in the evening and with the use of heavy equipment which are violations of existing laws, rules and regulations promulgated to ensure the observance of the proper and humane demolitions;

WHEREAS, it is very impossible to maintain peace and order during the implementation of demolition orders if those who are called to provide security and maintain peace and order during such undertakings are neither fully aware of their duties and responsibilities during demolition, nor well versed on the laws, rules and regulations governing squatting and implementation of demolition orders;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the District Director of the Central Police District Command (CPDC) to require that only police officials who have orientation on laws, rules and regulations governing squatting and demolition shall be assigned to provide security and maintain peace and order during the implementation of any demolition orders.


