RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP- 822~~, S-97

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE EIGHTEEN (18) FAMILIES WHOSE HOUSES WERE BURNED AT 36 MABILIS STREET, BARANGAY PINYAHAN, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, ON DECEMBER 13, 1996, IN THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, AND ALLOCATING THE SUM OF NINETEEN THOUSAND PESOS (P19,000.00) FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council is empowered under Section 458 (a) (1) (iv) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disaster and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events;"

WHEREAS, on December 13, 1996, the houses at 36 Mabilis Street, Barangay Pinyahan, District IV, Quezon City, were hit by fire rendering homeless, as per census by the Social Services Development Department (SSDD), eighteen (18) families categorized as follows:

Family Owners	One	1
Family Renters	Four	4
Family Sharers	Thirteen	<u>13</u>
Total	Eighteen	18

WHEREAS, because of this unfortunate incident, our constituents, who are presently in makeshift dwellings can only hope for and pray for the early release of financial assistance from the City government;

WHEREAS, these unfortunate fire victims need the assistance of the City government in the form of financial and to defray the cost of building materials for the reconstruction of their houses, foods, clothing and other necessary expenses in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for each house-owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for each house renter/sharer;


NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance to the eighteen (18) families whose houses were burned at 36 Mabilis Street, Barangay Pinyahan, District IV, Quezon City, on December 13, 1996, at the sum of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer and allocating the sum of Nineteen Thousand Pesos (P19,000.00) from Grants, Subsidies and Contributions of the City's Annual Budget or from any available funds of the City Treasury.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department shall validate and authenticate the list of fire victims categorized into family owner, family renter and family sharer and to submit the same to the Office of the Mayor, likewise making representation for the early release of the financial assistance to qualified recipients.
