RESOLUTION NO. SP- 857 , S-98

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE VIRGILIO R. NEBRIL, JR., A FORMER POLICE AUXILIARY, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY, QUEZON CITY, THE AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE 1998 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the late Virgilio R. Nebril, Jr., was a former Police Auxiliary (Traffic Enforcer) in the Department of Public Order and Safety, Quezon City, who, while directing traffic along Quirino Highway, Sangandaan, Quezon City, in the evening of July 6, 1991, was sideswiped by an Isuzu van, which necessitated an operation and his confinement at the National Orthopedic Hospital, Quezon City,

WHEREAS, the injuries he suffered impaired his mobility rendering him unfit for his former position, so that he was sidelined and given a desk assignment as an emergency employee;

WHEREAS, the incident affected his brain, giving him chronic headaches of which he died, diagnosed later as brain abcess chronic;

WHEREAS, having died in a job related ailment incurred in line of duty, Virgilio R. Nebril, Jr., deserves to be extended financial assistance to lighten the burden of his bereaved widow and two minor children occasioned by his untimely death;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) to the family of the late Virgilio R. Nebril, Jr., a former police auxiliary, Department of Public Order and Safety, Quezon City, the amount to be charged against the appropriation for Grants, Subsidies and Contributions in the 1998 Annual Budget of the Office of the City Mayor or from any available funds therein.
