RESOLUTION NO. 860, S-98

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P200,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE 1998 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY COUNCIL, AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO MS. AIDA A. ALVAREZ WHO WAS ENDORSED BY THE HONORABLE VICE MAYOR AND PRESIDING OFFICER TO TAKE HER MASTERAL STUDY AT CAMP CRAME, QUEZON CITY, A JOINT UNDERTAKING OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) AND THE BICOL UNIVERSITY, LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF MASTER OF ARTS IN PEACE AND SECURITY STUDIES.

WHEREAS, Article XIV, of the 1987 Constitution explicitly provides that:

"Art. XIV - Education, Science and Technology, Culture and Sports

Education

Section 1. The State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all.

Section 2. The State shall:

(3) Establish and maintain a system of scholarships, grants, student loans programs, subsidies and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, especially to the underprivileged."

WHEREAS, Section 458 of the same Code further provides that:

“Section 458. Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. -
(a) the sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants, pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:

(5) Approve ordinances, which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code, and in addition to said services and facilities, shall:

(xi) Establish a scholarship fund for the poor but deserving students in schools located within its jurisdiction or for students residing within the city.

WHEREAS, Ms. Aida A. Alvarez is a licensed Criminologist and a regular employee of the Quezon City government with a position of Legislative Staff Officer V of the Ordinance and Resolution Section under the Legislative Services Division of the Office of the Secretary to the Sanggunian Panlungsod;

WHEREAS, the said required masteral study will result to improve personnel performance and more effective and competent administration by way of assisting the city government in its decision-making process and execution of vital programs, however, such under taking requires an additional financial burden to her as she is now writing her Thesis Paper entitled: “Barangay Security Development Program in Quezon City, A Proposal”;

WHEREAS, the attainment of such masteral degree can be fully realized with the grant of assistance for the payment of tuition fees and expenses for her travel abroad, a class tour to their counter parts in North Korea, Singapore and Indonesia which is one of the academic requirements for graduation;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allocate, as it does hereby allocate, the amount of TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND (P200,000.00) PESOS to be taken from Grants, Subsidies and Contributions from the 1998 Annual Budget of the City Council, as financial assistance to Ms. Aida A. Alvarez who was endorsed by the Vice Mayor
