RESOLUTION NO. SP- 965 S-98

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL, QCGH-STA. LUCIA ANNEX HOSPITAL AND QCGH-NOVALICHES ANNEX HOSPITAL TO USE HOSPITAL INCOME DERIVED FROM DONATIONS AND PAYMENTS OF HOSPITAL FEES DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR (1997), IN ADDITION TO THE CURRENT HOSPITAL APPROPRIATION IN 1998 BUDGET AS A CONTINUING APPROPRIATION TO AUGMENT THE INSUFFICIENT MAINTENANCE OPERATION EXPENSES FOR THE PURCHASE OF EMERGENCY MEDICINES, MEDICAL SUPPLIES, REPAIR OF HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT AND EMERGENCY REPAIR OF HOSPITAL STRUCTURES, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH) is the only 250-bed capacity tertiary, regional, and general local government hospital of Quezon City which was created by virtue of Republic Act No. 6548 as one of the department of the Quezon City government that will provide comprehensive quality care to the residents of the City, especially the urban poor;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital, being the only local government hospital, has to absorb all the referrals from the fifty-four (54) City Health Centers, five (5) Lying-In Clinics and nine (9) Acute Care Centers for hospitalizations and even has to admit transferees from private tertiary hospitals;

WHEREAS, the QCGH statistics clearly show that the total annual discharges had increased from 12,000 patients in 1989 to about 18,000 in 1997 which reflects the 3.4% population growth of Quezon City, mostly indigents;

WHEREAS, the annual cost of service in handling in-patients as reflected in the cost analysis ranges between P28 million to P29 million during the past three (3) years;

WHEREAS, for the past three (3) years, only about P12 million annually was actually transferred as government subsidy which is even less than 50% of the actual requirement of the hospital to be able to operate effectively and optimally;

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WHEREAS, the hospital through its efforts to raise revenues was able to collect about 25% of its costs of service through donations and payments of hospital fees;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City General Hospital, QCGH-Sta. Lucia Annex Hospital and QCGH-Novaliches Annex Hospital to use hospital income derived from donations and payments of hospital fees during the previous year (1997), in addition to the current hospital appropriation in 1998 budget as a continuing appropriation to augment the insufficient maintenance operation expenses for the purchase of emergency medicines, medical supplies, repair of hospital equipment and emergency repair of hospital structures, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
