RESOLUTION NO. SP- 968, S-98

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., AND THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (U.P.) COLLEGE OF MASS COMMUNICATION FOUNDATION (UP CMC), REPRESENTED BY DR. REYNALDO GUIOGUIO, FOR THE PRODUCTION OF A SHORT FILM TRAILER DEPICTING THE HISTORICAL LEGACY OF THE CITY AT THE COST OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P400,000.00), TO BE SHOWN IN QUEZON CITY MOVIE HOUSES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION OF THE PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE.


