RESOLUTION NO. SP- 972 - 13-98

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE COMMENDATION AND CONGRATULATIONS OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO HONORABLE JORGE L. BANAL, FOR HIS INVALUABLE SERVICES AS VICE MAYOR OF QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II, WILMA AMORANTO-SARINO, ANTONIO L. SIOSON, MA. FRESCA M. BIGLANG-AWA, MARCIANO P. MEDALLA, NANETTE CASTELO DAZA, ALFREDO A. FRANCISCO (Fred Montilla) and HERMINIA C. ALTUNA.

WHEREAS, Hon. Jorge L. Banal, prior to his entry to the field of public service and governance, was a distinguished captain of industry and a respected socio-civic leader acting on several capacities of responsibility and leadership, such as, Faithful Navigator, Padre Gomez Assembly, 4th Degree of the Knights of Columbus, President of the Quezon City Jaycees Senate Foundation, Vice Chairman of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Quezon City Council and the N.C.R., respectively, and the Charter President of the Rotary Club of Katipunan, to name a few;

WHEREAS, Hon. Jorge L. Banal was elected City Councilor representing the Third Legislative District in the 1998 elections where he was subsequently elected as Majority Floor Leader and Chairman of the City Council Committees on Laws, Rules and Internal Government; Education, Cultural and Tourism Affairs; Trade and Commerce; and Vice Chairman of the Task Force on Street Children;

WHEREAS, during the 7th City Council, Hon. Jorge L. Banal became the Assistant Minority Floor Leader and Chairman of the City Council's Committee on People's Participation and Vice Chairman of the Committees on Labor, Employment and Conciliation and Trade, Commerce and Industry and Member of the City Council's various standing committees and consequently, First Assistant Majority Floor Leader;

WHEREAS, on 7 April 1998, by operation of law and applying the rules of succession, Hon. Jorge L. Banal was sworn into office as Vice Mayor and Presiding Officer of the City Council of Quezon City by no less than the City Mayor, Hon. Ismael A. Mathay, Jr.;

WHEREAS, his leadership and genuine concern for the youth and our underprivileged residents had led him to author and support numerous socially relevant legislation meant to uplift their standard of living;

WHEREAS, Hon. Jorge L. Banal's mastery of the craft of argumentation and debate has contributed much to the lively and unhampered discussion of vital local legislation presented on the plenary floor, a testament to his independence, indisputable integrity and courage, earning for him a nich in the rolls of "Most Outstanding Councilors of Quezon City" in the year 1990, 1996 and 1997 as Manuel Luis Quezon Bantayog Awardee;

WHEREAS, owing to his genuine leadership and unblemished track record as local legislator, Hon. Jorge L. Banal was re-elected Number One City Councilor of the Third Legislative District of Quezon City, in the recently concluded General Elections of 1998, proving that his political career has yet to reach its apex;


NOW, THEREFORE,
