WHEREAS, Hon. Emilio G. Tamayo - illustrious son of Malasiqui, Pangasinan, distinguished alumnus of the Mapua Institute of Technology, College of Agriculture, accomplished architect, able Head of Quezon City Community Relations Office, and proud father to a brood of seven - began his political career in 1988 when he was first elected Councilor representing the First District of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, through hardwork and dedication, Councilor Emilio G. Tamayo was re-elected for a second term in 1992, and for a third and final term in 1995, during which the period he was twice a recipient of the prestigious Manuel L. Quezon Bantayog Awards as one of the Six Outstanding Councilors of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in the three terms that he was elected, Councilor Emilio G. Tamayo served the City Council with distinction as Chairman of the Committee on Public Works and Infrastructure, the Committee on Peace and Order, Public Welfare and Safety, the Committee on Environmental Protection and Ecology, the Committee on City Planning, Building and Zoning Regulations and representative to the Quezon City Peace and Order Council; and as a fitting climax to a decade of distinguished political career, the President Pro-Tempore of the Fourteenth (14th) City Council;

WHEREAS, true to his role as a legislator, Councilor Emilio G. Tamayo authored several landmark ordinances, notably the "Quezon City Zoning Ordinance of 1992" and the "Comprehensive Land Use Plan of Quezon City", and widely acknowledged as the "Father" of several offices/agencies created under his sponsorship such as the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB), the Office for Senior Citizen's Affairs (OSCA), the Disabled Persons Affairs Committee (DPAC), the City Electrical Engineer's Office, the Zoning Administration Unit, and the Office of the City Building Official;


