RESOLUTION NO. SP- 974 S-98

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE HEARTFELT COMMENDATION AND CONGRATULATIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO HONORABLE ALBERTO M. GALARPE FOR HIS EXEMPLARY AND OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE AS A COUNCILOR OF THE FIRST DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY FOR THREE (3) CONSECUTIVE TERMS FROM 1988 TO 1998.

WHEREAS, Hon. Alberto M. Galarpe began his career in public service as a humble Clerk at the Office of the Mayor in 1951, from which he rose from the ranks until he retired as Chief of the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Hon. Galarpe was thereafter elected as Councilor of the 1st District of Quezon City for three (3) consecutive terms;

WHEREAS, Hon. Galarpe is also an active socio-civic leader having been a member of past director of the Quezon City Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Director of the Quezon City of Tourism, Corporate Member of the YMCA-Quezon City, Past President of the Toro Hills Homeowners Association, President of the Rotary Club of Central EDSA; Board Member, Philippine National Red Cross (PNRC) Quezon City Chapter, to mention a few;

WHEREAS, Hon. Galarpe's wide and vast experience in the BPLO has earned for him the distinction of "The Master of Taxation" of the City Council, thus enabling him to craft measures towards the effective and efficient generation of revenues needed to support the various programs, projects and activities of the Quezon City government, especially those for the alleviation of the underprivileged residents of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Hon. Galarpe is the Principal Author of Ordinance No. SP-357, Series of 1996, Ordaining the Revision of the Fair Market Values of all Real Property located in Quezon City and other relevant revenue-generating measures and social legislations including the Liquor Ordinance and the Ordinance creating the Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board;

WHEREAS, Hon. Galarpe's fearless and oftentimes searching questions have provoked lively and exciting discussions of various issues and concerns that affect the efficient and effective delivery of basic services to the inhabitants of the City;

WHEREAS, as City Councilor for three (3) consecutive terms, Hon. Galarpe had served in the City Council in various capacities, such as Majority Floor Leader, Chairman of the Committees on Laws, Rules and Internal Government, Ways and Means, Public Affairs and Information, and Vice Chairman of the Committees of the City Council;

WHEREAS, Hon. Galarpe has devoted close to four decades of dedicated and unblemished public service - unparalleled and difficult to replicate in these most trying times and thus, his retirement from the Quezon City Council would definitely create a big void in the City Council;


WHEREAS, the Hon. Alberto M. Galarpe is the epitome of an exceptional leader and public servant worthy of emulation and respect;
