RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2431**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORTING SENATE BILL NO. 2443, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE MAGNA CARTA FOR DAY CARE WORKERS, PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

Introduced by Councilors AIKO MELENDEZ, DIORELLA MARIA SOTTO-DE LEON and BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Voltaire Godofredo L. Liban III, Ramon P. Medalla, Allan Butch T. Francisco, Eric Z. Medina, Jorge L. Banal, Franz S. Pumaren and Antonio E. Inton, Jr.

WHEREAS, there is a Senate Bill No. 2443, authored by Senator Robert S. Jaworski, "An act granting the Magna Carta for Day Care Workers, providing funds therefore and for other purposes";

WHEREAS, this policy aims to improve the social and economic status of Day Care Workers, to protect their rights and to promote their welfare;

WHEREAS, this act shall cover all persons engaged in providing early childhood development in government sponsored Day Care Centers whose primary function is to assist in the care of the children and provide social development, education and other needs of children;

WHEREAS, this bill will benefit all Day Care Workers of the Philippines, including the Day Care Workers of Quezon City.


NOW, THEREFORE,




