RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2433, S-2004

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (P88,000.00), TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE BUDGET FOR THE REPAIR OF HOBART VILLAGE BASKETBALL COURT LOCATED AT BARANGAY KALIGAYAHAN, NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Hobart Village basketball court has already been donated to the Quezon City government by the Hobart Realty and Development Corporation on July 22, 1994;

WHEREAS, by virtue of its donation, the maintenance, repair and preservation thereof, now lies within the hand of the City government being a city-owned property;

WHEREAS, Mr. Remberto C. Lantin, President of Hobart Village Homeowners Association, Inc. (HVHAI), in his letter of 28 September 2003 addressed to the undersigned proponent, requested the repair of the said basketball court to serve as the recreation area for the village inhabitants;


