A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CONTRACT OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTION, CLEANING AND DISPOSAL SERVICES AND OPERATION ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND DODGE SERVICES CORPORATION, GREENLINE ONLY ENVIRONTECH, HALREY SERVICES, INC., OMNI HAULING SERVICES, INC., UPM CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT, CARC ENTERPRISES, AND FCS TRANSPORT SERVICES UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2004.

WHEREAS, Quezon City generates almost 1,500 tons of waste daily;


WHEREAS, the continuity of the garbage collection/hauling services is a paramount concern of the City to avoid possible serious sanitation and health problem;
