A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CONTRACT OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTION, CLEANING AND DISPOSAL SERVICES AND OPERATION ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND DODGE SERVICES CORPORATION, GREENLINE ONYX ENVIRONTECH, HALREY SERVICES, INC., OMNI HAULING SERVICES, INC., IPM CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT, CARC ENTERPRISES, AND FCS TRANSPORT SERVICES UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2004.

WHEREAS, there is a need to extend the contract for solid waste collection, cleaning and disposal services and special operations because there is no more ample time to conduct a public bidding and in order not to disrupt the said operation;


