RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2571**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MARCH 24, 2004 VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF THIRTY-FOUR (34) FAMILIES AT KAKAWATE STREET, BARANGAY BALINGASA, DISTRICT 1, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.

WHEREAS, because of the said calamity, they are experiencing financial difficulties resulting from the incident, and shall therefore be provided assistance in form of cash;


