RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2622**, S-2004

RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, TO CONSIDER THE REQUEST OF THE URBAN POOR OF QUEZON CITY IN THE INSTALLATION OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL AS PATRON SAINT OF THE URBAN POOR OF QUEZON CITY

Introduced by Councilors WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., ERIC Z. MEDINA, RAMON P. MEDALLA and BAYANI V. HIPOL.

WHEREAS, Saint Vincent De Paul, in his profession as a priest organized "Help for the Poor" where they traveled to villages and visited the poor as missionaries and worked to supply them with food, clothing and other necessities;

WHEREAS, Saint Vincent De Paul as a Roman Catholic Leader founded two important religious orders namely: Daughters of Charity (now often called Sisters of Charity) the largest catholic order for women worldwide and Congregation of the Mission for Men where it directed seminaries and organized conferences and retreats to train young priests;

WHEREAS, as of today, there are more than one million members in 120 countries which include the Philippines working and serving the poor inspired by the spirit of Saint Vincent de Paul under "The Saint Vincent de Paul Society";

WHEREAS, relative to the upcoming feast of Saint Vincent de Paul on September 27, it is but necessary as a way of paying tribute to make him the patron saint of the Urban Poor of Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr. to consider the request of the Urban Poor of Quezon City in the installation of Saint Vincent de Paul as the patron saint of the Urban Poor of Quezon City.
