RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2774**, S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED ON JANUARY 21, 2005 ALONG LIWANAG STREET, BARANGAY MATANDANG BALARA, DISTRICT III, THIS CITY COMPRISING OF FORTY-FIVE (45) FAMILIES AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) EACH FAMILY HOMEOWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) EACH FAMILY RENTER/SHARER IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF NINETY THOUSAND PESOS (P90,000.00) TO BE CHARGED FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUND OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, a fire occurred last January 21, 2005 along Liwanag Street, Barangay Matandang Balara, District III, this City rendering Forty-Four (45) families homeowners/renters/sharers homeless;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Section 458 (1) (iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of

the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities in their return to productive livelihood following said events.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to grant financial assistance to the victims of the fire that occurred on January 21, 2005 along Liwanag Street, Barangay Matandang Balara, District III, this City comprising of Forty-Five (45) families at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) each family homeowner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) each family renter/sharer in the total amount of Ninety Thousand Pesos (P90,000.00) to be charged from Grants, Subsidies and Contributions of the Office of the City Mayor or from any available fund of the City Treasury.
