A RESOLUTION URGING QUEZON CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED ON OCTOBER 16, 2004 AT PHASE 3 BLOCK 2 PAYATAS B, BARANGAY PAYATAS, QUEZON COMPRISING CITY OF. FIVE (5) FAMILIES. HOMEOWNERS/RENTERS/SHARERS AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) EACH IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND (P10,000,00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUND OF THE CITY TREASURY.
