RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2755**, S-2005

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SIXTY THREE (63) FAMILIES WHOSE HOUSES WERE BURNED BY FIRE AT NO. 23 SAINT VINCENT STREET, BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY ON OCTOBER 26, 2004 AT AROUND THREE O' CLOCK IN THE MORNING, AT THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER, AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, AND ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council is empowered under Section 458 (a), (1), (iv) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events";

WHEREAS, an unfortunate event occurred in the early morning of October 26, 2004 at No. 23 Saint Vincent Street, Barangay Holy Spirit, Quezon City, when fire gutted the area, rendering sixty three (63) families homeless;

WHEREAS, these unfortunate fire victims need the assistance of the City government in the form of financial aid to defray the cost of building materials for the reconstruction of their houses, foods, clothing and other necessary expenses in the amount of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00) for each house owner and one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) for each house renter/sharer.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance to the Sixty Three (63) families whose houses were burned by fire at No. 23 Saint Vincent Street, Barangay Holy Spirit, District II, Quezon City on October 26, 2004, at around three o' clock in the morning, at the sum of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner, and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer, and allocating the amount necessary to be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City government or from any available funds in the City Treasury.
