RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2760**, S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR, TO ALLOCATE THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO (142) SERVICE MINI FIRETRUCKS FOR THE USE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO (142) BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE 2005 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (1) (IV) of the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance to victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, at present, fire is a usual calamity or disaster often ravaging not only Quezon City but even its neighboring cities and municipalities;

WHEREAS, it cannot be denied that due to inadequacy of service firetrucks of the Bureau of Fire Protection in Quezon City, it cannot effectively dispatch its duties to the residents of Quezon City whenever the contingency for its use arises;

WHEREAS, corollary to this event, there is a need to equip the One Hundred Forty Two (142) barangays of Quezon City with a service mini firetrucks each in order to enhance their mobility whenever the contingency for its use arises geared towards fire prevention;

WHEREAS, providing the different barangays of Quezon City with service mini firetrucks would not only be of great help to all the residents of Quezon City but also to the neighboring cities and municipalities.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable Quezon City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to allocate the necessary funds for the procurement of One Hundred Forty-Two (142) service mini firetrucks for the use of the One Hundred Forty-Two (142) barangays of Quezon City to be charged against the 2005 Annual Budget of the Quezon City government.
