A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX PESOS (P1,874,686.00) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TWO-STOREY PURPOSE HALL FOR THE SAMAHAN NG MGA SENIOR CITIZENS NG FAIRVIEW, INC., REPRESENTED BY THEIR PRESIDENT, MRS. PAZ C. VILLORIA, LOCATED AT BARANGAY GREATER FAIRVIEW, QUEZON CITY TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.
