RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2780**, S-2005

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO DIRECT THE CHIEF OF THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL SERVICES OFFICE TO DETERMINE, INDICATE AND DESIGNATE THE PROPER VENDING AREA OF COOKED FOOD WITHIN THE QUEZON CITY HALL AND TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT EXISTING PERTINENT POLICIES, RULES AND REGULATIONS ON THE MATTER.

WHEREAS, it is observed that the ambulant peddlers of cooked food are back in their old practice of selling cooked food to the employees of the Quezon City government, and those transacting business in City Hall, in the passageways of the City Hall, lobby, front and backyards, sidewalks, and almost everywhere in the City Hall Complex, thereby presenting a chaotic situation without any sense of discipline and order;

WHEREAS, in the light of the present dread arising from the report of possible break out of various diseases which affect the health of our constituent, there is a need to observe existing rules on health and sanitation;

WHEREAS, the vending of cooked food at particularly every available space in the City Hall Complex, without regard of existing health and sanitation rules, could adversely affect the health of our people.
