A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED PESOS (P100.00) PER DAY TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT SUMMONED TO RENDER COURT DUTY.

WHEREAS, police officers are at the forefront of our criminal justice system tasked to effect lawful arrests and conduct police investigations relative to the same making them indispensable and/or necessary witnesses in the prosecution of criminal crimes;

WHEREAS, once the prosecution of crimes commenced in our courts, police officers effecting arrests and conducting police investigations are summoned to act as witnesses as part of our judicial system;

WHEREAS, it is common knowledge that due to lack of funds within the Philippine National Police (PNP), the police officers summoned to render court duty invariably use their money and/or personal account in attending court hearings;

WHEREAS, in order to attain the ends of justice, those police officers rendering court duty must be given at least an allowance for their transportation and miscellaneous expenses as an incentive for their lawful duties;

WHEREAS, in the face of an economic crisis befalling our country today, it is imperative that our police officers receive a per diem allowance of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) a day as a buffer allowance so they can perform their court duties without additional strain on their personal expenses.
