A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND MANILA WATER CORPORATION FOR THEIR TUBIG SA BARANGAY PROJECT AND OTHER WATER SERVICES PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, Manila Water Corporation, by virtue of the concession agreement with Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System, has the sole right to manage, operate, repair, decommission and refurbish the facilities in the service area west which include parts of Quezon City,

WHEREAS, Manila Water Corporation has programmed to improve the water facilities within its service area by laying down pipelines in various areas within the jurisdiction of Quezon City, among others the Tubig sa Barangay Project,

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government, which has jurisdiction over these project sites, and the Manila Water Corporation, have agreed to enter into an agreement which will embody the rights and obligations of both parties.
