A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE MORTUARY ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR THEIR "SERBISYONG PALIBING" PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the "Libreng Palibing" program's objective is to extend free funeral and burial services to qualified beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, the indigent constituents cannot afford the high cost of funeral and burial services;


