A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO CONSTRUCT A MINI PUBLIC LIBRARY AT SB PLAZA PREMISES, QUIRINO HIGHWAY, BARANGAY NOVALICHES PROPER, QUEZON CITY, THE FUND TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND OR ANY AVAILABLE FUND OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, the public library located within the Quezon City Hall premises is too far to be availed of by students and residents of Novaliches area;

WHEREAS, there is a growing need of students and residents of Novaliches, of a public library that is accessible to them in that area;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to construct a mini public library that is updated and responsive to modern times.
