RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2812 , S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A GOVERNMENT-OWNED CREMATORIUM IN AN APPROPRIATE PLACE IN QUEZON CITY, THE FUND TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND OR ANY AVAILABLE FUND OF THE CITY TREASURY.

Introduced by Councilors RAMON P. MEDALLA, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, FRANZ S. PUMAREN, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., JANET M. MALAYA, RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN and BAYANI V. HIPOL.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-1400, S-2004 mandates the construction of a government-owned crematorium;

WHEREAS, public cemeteries particularly Bagbag, Baesa, Novaliches and La Loma, are now crowded as a burial site for lack of space;

WHEREAS, construction of a government-owned crematorium in Quezon City will declog public cemeteries and save needed spaces to cater the growing felt need specially those from the urban poor;

WHEREAS, an affordable cremation can greatly benefit the City's indigent residents.
