RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2819 3-2005

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE OCTOBER 25, 2004 VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF MORE OR LESS FIFTY-TWO (52) FAMILIES AT ST. VINCENT STREET, BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, THIS CITY AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) FAMILY PER RENTER/SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2004 at Barangay Holy Spirit, specifically St. Vincent Street, District II, Quezon City was hit by fire that burned the houses of more or less fifty-two (52) families, who are now in dire need of financial assistance most especially from the City government;

WHEREAS, due to such unfortunate event, they are experiencing financial difficulties resulting from the incident, and shall therefore be provided assistance in the form of cash;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Section (458) (a) (1) (iv) of Republic Act 7160, local government are empowered to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of the man-made or natural calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities, and their return to productive livelihood following said events."
