A RESOLUTION URGING THE METROPOLITAN WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE SYSTEM TO DISPOSE THEIR PROPERTIES LOCATED AT COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, BARANGAY NORTH FAIRVIEW, TO ACTUAL BONAFIDE MEMBERS OF THE NAMASAPE, SAMASAPE, AND NAMAPA, THRU VARIOUS SOCIALIZED HOUSING SCHEME OF THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COORDINATING COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System owns the land located at Commonwealth Avenue, Barangay North Fairview, Quezon City,

WHEREAS, the afore-mentioned parcel of land have been occupied openly and continuously for the last thirty (30) years by about 400 families who have organized themselves into three (3) groups, namely: NAMASAPE, SAMASAPE and NAMAPA;

WHEREAS, the actual occupants are now soliciting the assistance of the City government and the Honorable City Council and convince the MWSS to implement the "On Site Development Program" in the disposition of the MWSS land as an initial step in their quest for a decent shelter.
