RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2834_{S-2005}

A RESOLUTION URGING HIS HONOR, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO DIRECT THE DISTRICT DIRECTOR, CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT, PNP, QUEZON CITY, TO DESIGN AND SUBMIT A MORE AGGRESSIVE ENFORCEMENT PLAN IN THE BARANGAY LEVEL, FULLY ATTUNED TO THE NATIONAL EFFORT AND STRATEGY, THAT ASSURES A MORE EFFECTIVE APPREHENSION AND PROSECUTION OF ALL VIOLATORS OF R.A. 9208, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS ANTI TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS ACT OF 2003.

Introduced by Councilors BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO and RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN.

WHEREAS, human trafficking is a violation of human rights guaranteed by the Constitution, thus this illegal activity deprives women and children of enhancing their dignity;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9208 also known as the Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003 expressly prohibits the trafficking of persons by any means for the purpose of prostitution, pornography and sexual exploitation;

WHEREAS, in the realization of this noble objective, it has become necessary for the Philippine National Police (PNP) in Quezon City to design an enforcement plan/strategy in the barangay level that will complement the efforts of the national government to reduce, if not eradicate, the human trafficking in this country.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, His Honor, City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to direct the District Director, Central Police District, PNP, Quezon City, to design and submit a more aggressive enforcement plan in the barangay level, fully attuned to the national effort and strategy, that assures a more effective apprehension and prosecution of all violators of R.A. 9208, otherwise known as anti-trafficking in persons act of 2003.
