A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, LAND REGISTRATION AUTHORITY, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES - NCR, REGISTRY OF DEEDS – QC AND BUREAU OF INTERNAL REVENUE – NATIONAL OFFICE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LAND ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT PROJECT (LAMP).

WHEREAS, the President of the Republic of the Philippines, by virtue of Executive Order No. 82 created the Presidential Task Force to coordinate the efforts of all relevant agencies in the implementation of the Land Administration and Management Project (LAMP);

WHEREAS, the above name agencies, through an interagency MOA dated September 13, 2000 and the Supplemental MOA, have committed to their participation in LAMP through the Quezon City Prototype Office – the Project Implementation Office 2 (PIO2) to achieve the objective of developing and testing alternative approaches for land records management and associated institutional arrangements that will improve the protection of rights to land and public confidence in the system;

WHEREAS, PIO2, through the LAMP, shall be responsible to provide the necessary equipment, training of staff, and other budget requirements to support the operation of the One Stop Shop (OSS);

WHEREAS, the Quezon City local government will provide counter part funds in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,500,000.00) to be used for purchasing of the following items: two (2) Cisco Routers, server and software package, hot swappable hard disk, fire proof cabinets and all billboards in support of the OSS operation.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify, the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and between the Quezon City government, Land Registration Authority, Department of Environment and Natural Resources - NCR, Registry of Deeds - QC and Bureau of Internal Revenue - National Office for the implementation of Land Administration and Management Project (LAMP).
