RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2877** S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ALLOCATE THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CITY GOVERNMENT-OWNED MORTUARY CHAPEL IN EVERY DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY IN AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION TO BE DETERMINED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE 2005 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, number of residents in Quezon City necessitates the construction of one government-owned mortuary chapel so as to provide burial assistance to all the residents of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the said facility in view of the number of families who could avail of the services to be offered thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE,


Mortuary Chapel in every district of Quezon City in an appropriate location to be determined by the Quezon City government to be charged against the 2005 Annual Budget of the City Government.
