RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2900, S-2005

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT FOR THE CONVERSION OF THE TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATIONS (TODAs) INTO TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVES, AS MANDATED BY HER EXCELLENCY PRESIDENT GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO UNDER MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 116 ENTITLED, "ENCOURAGING THE CONVERSION OF TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATIONS (TODA) INTO TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVES."

WHEREAS, in response to the clamor of the Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODAs) in a rally held in Cuneta Astrodome on 03 January 2003, the government has sought the establishment of Transport Service Cooperatives;

WHEREAS, the conversion of tricycle operations into transport service cooperatives will serve as a practical vehicle for promoting self reliance and harnessing people power in the attainment of economic growth, development and social justice towards the envisioned strong Republic;

WHEREAS, the conversion of the TODAs into transport service cooperatives will make them eligible for various project/programs of the government designed primarily for the poor and marginalized sectors of our society;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Memorandum Order No. 116, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo directed the Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC), thru the Office of Transportation Cooperatives (OTC) as the lead agency, to enhance and intensify the voluntary conversion of tricycle operators/associations into transport service cooperatives, in close coordination with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) thru the Bureau of Local Government Development (BLGD); and

WHEREAS, the DILG issued Memorandum Circular No. 2002-35 dated 07 March 2002 urging all Local Government Units/Executives and all other concerned to support the Koop Paradahan, Pook Sakayahan (KPPS) project and the conversion of tricycle associations into transport service cooperatives.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, full support for the conversion of the Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODAs) into Transport Service Cooperatives, as mandated by Her Excellency President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo under Memorandum Order No. 116 entitled, "Encouraging the Conversion of Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODA) into Transport Service Cooperatives."

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished the TODAs in Quezon City for their information and guidance.
