A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON JUSTICE AND HUMAN RIGHTS TO STUDY, LOOK INTO AND INVESTIGATE THE REPORTED DEATH OF PRISONERS IN THE QUEZON CITY JAIL ALLEGEDLY DUE TO OVER CROWDING AND CONGESTION, AND TO SUBMIT A REPORT THEREON WITH RECOMMENDATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE PLIGHT OF THE PRISONERS THEREAT.

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for the city administration to look into said reports, and for the city authorities to initiate and undertake the necessary measures which will improve the plight of the prisoners in the city jail.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to direct, as it does hereby direct, the Committee on Justice and Human Rights of the Quezon City Council to look into, study and investigate the reported occurrence of death among the prisoners of the Quezon City jail due to over crowding and congestion in said jail, and to submit a report to the City Council, with recommendations on the adoption of such measures as may be necessary to improve the plight of the prisoners thereat.
