RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2918 \$2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MARCH 26, 2005 VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT GUTTED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF MORE OR LESS THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY (370) FAMILIES LOCATED IN PECHAYAN, BARANGAY OLD CAPITOL SITE, QUEZON CITY AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND.

WHEREAS, Quezon City is empowered under Section 458 (a), (1), (iv) of R. A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of the man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disaster and calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said events";

WHEREAS, these unfortunate fire victims need the assistance of the City government in the form of financial aid to defray the cost of the building materials for the reconstruction of their houses, purchase of foods, clothing and other necessary expenses at the sum of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for each house owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for each house renter/sharer,

WHEREAS, because of this unfortunate incident, the Three Hundred Seventy (370) families consisting of One Hundred Seventy-Four (174) house owners, One Hundred Forty-Five (145) renters and Fifty-One (51) sharers who are presently in makeshift dwellings can only hope for the early release of financial assistance from the City government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Hon. Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to extend financial assistance to the March 26, 2005 victims of the fire that gutted the residential houses of more or less Three Hundred Seventy (370) families located at Pechayan, Barangay Old Capitol Site, Quezon City at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer which shall be taken from the Calamity or Emergency Fund of the City government or from any available funds of the City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Service Development Department (SSDD) shall validate and authenticate the list of the fire victims categorized into family owner, family renter/sharer and to submit the same to the office of the City Mayor likewise making representation for the early release of the financial assistance to the qualified recipients.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the office of the City Mayor shall revalidate and confirm the list submitted by the Social Service Development Department (SSDD) which will be the basis for the preparation of the payroll and to approve the immediate release of the funds allocated for the purpose.
