RESOLUTION NO. SP. 2928 , S-2005

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SEPTEMBER 7, 2004 VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF ELEVEN (11) FAMILIES AT #14 YELLOW STREET, APOCAR SUBDIVISION, BARANGAY TANDANG SORA, THIS CITY AT ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2004, Barangay Tandang Sora, specifically Yellow Street, District II, this City was hit by fire that burned the houses of eleven (11) families, who are now in dire need of financial assistance most especially from the City government;

WHEREAS, due to such unfortunate event, they are experiencing financial difficulties resulting from the incident, and shall therefore be provided assistance in the form of cash;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Section 458 (a) (1) (iv) of R.A. 7160, local governments are empowered to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effect of the man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said event."
