A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIS HONOR, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE METROPOLITAN WATER WORKS AND SEWERAGE SYSTEM THRU ITS CHAIRMAN, MR. ORLANDO HONDRADE, FOR THE DONATION OF A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED AT MOLAVE STREET CORNER LITEX ROAD, BARANGAY PAYATAS HIGH SCHOOL ANNEX, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the MWSS has express their willingness to donate said parcel of land provided it will be utilized for educational purposes;

WHEREAS, the construction of an educational annex for the Payatas High School will decongest the enrollment of students and make education accessible to all.
