A RESOLUTION URGING HIS HONOR, FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO CAUSE THE ISSUANCE OF TAMPER-PROOF SENIOR CITIZEN'S IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO QUALIFIED QUEZON CITY SENIOR CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, senior citizens all over the country are entitled to certain privileges granted by law;

WHEREAS, other privileges may also be granted to such senior citizens through local legislation;

WHEREAS, as required by law, local government units are mandated to issue, upon due application, the appropriate senior citizens' identification cards to enable them to avail of the privileges granted by law;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the abuse of the privileges granted to senior citizens by ensuring that only qualified senior citizens are able to enjoy these privileges.
