RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2954 S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO PROMOTE A GREATER EQUAL ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE IN QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, FRANCISCO A. CALALAY, JR., WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, RAMON P. MEDALLA, JORGE B. BANAL, JR., ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN.

WHEREAS, it is evident that there are substantial inequalities with respect to healthcare that remain among the citizens of Quezon City,

WHEREAS, poor health is concentrated in different barangay, because of lack of access to medical care, unhealthy behaviors and sub-standard living conditions;

WHEREAS, it is very urgent to promote greater health equity in the City, including

1. expanding partnerships for health improvement beyond health care and public health communities to include education, housing, employment and other sectors of society,
2. combining such expansion with specific, proven public health policies and interventions;
3. targeting resources and interventions to communities bearing the heaviest burdens of illness and premature death.

WHEREAS, eliminating health disparities in Quezon City would save thousands of lives each year.
