A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE, CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, WITH THE ROTARY CLUB OF QUEZON CITY, RI DISTRICT 3780, THE QUEZON CITY CHAMBERETTES, INC., AND THE ALLIANCE OF QUEZON CITY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., TO ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT A TULONG DAY CARE PROJECT IN PROVIDING SUPPORT, MORAL AND MATERIAL AND TO IMPROVE THE COMPETENCIES OF THE DAY CARE WORKERS.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the state to defend the right of children to assistance, including proper care and nutrition, and to provide them with special protection against all forms of neglect, abuse, cruelty, exploitation, and other conditions prejudicial to their development;

WHEREAS, Filipino children up to six (6) years of age deserves the best care and attention at the family and community levels;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government are presently maintaining 211 Day Care Centers and employing 207 Workers located in the depressed areas in the four (4) districts of Quezon City,

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to expand this program in order to reach more needy children, protect their interests and prevent the loss of these human potentials;

WHEREAS, the expansion of this program can be achieved with the collective efforts of the public and private sector through the active involvement of non-government organization, such as the Rotary Club of Quezon City, RI District 3780, the Quezon City Chamberettes, Inc. and the Alliance of Quezon City Homeowners Association, Inc.;

WHEREAS, with their mutual consent, agreed to adopt and implement a TULONG DAY CARE PROJECT which will consists mainly of providing support, moral and material, and to improve the competencies of the Day Care Workers in Quezon City's Day Care Center.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable, City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement in behalf of the Quezon City government, with the Rotary Club of Quezon City, RI District 3780, the Quezon City Chamberettes, Inc., and the Alliance of Quezon City Homeowners Association, Inc., to adopt and implement a Tulong Day Care Project in providing support, moral and material and to improve the competencies of the day care workers.


