WHEREAS, she served as Dean of the Diplomat Corps in Australia in 2001;

WHEREAS, before her appointment on 2003 as Secretary of Foreign Affairs, she served as Undersecretary for International Economic Relations as the Philippines Senior Official for the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation;

WHEREAS, she was also appointed Presidential Adviser for Multilateral Cooperation and Development and concurrently Presidential Adviser for mineral development;

WHEREAS, she had also attended the University of the Philippines as well as other academic institutions in Europe;

WHEREAS, she had also taken language courses in Tokyo, Geneva, Bucharrat and Bonn, she speaks English, German, French, Romanian, Spanish and Japanese in addition to her national language Filipino;

WHEREAS, in recognition of her efforts in promoting Philippine relations with Germany as well as relation between ASEAN and the European Union, she was awarded the Knights Commanders Cross of the Order of Merit with Star of the Federal Republic of Germany in 1992;


WHEREAS, during the Philippine Women's University 81st Commencement Exercise and 85th Anniversary on April 2, 2003, conferred on her the Degree of Doctor of Humanities, honorees causa in recognition of her contribution towards building a gender-fair society as the first woman Secretary of Foreign Affairs of the Philippines and in the ASEAN region.


