A RESOLUTION URGING ALL BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF QUEZON CITY TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT 9262 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE ANTI-VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND CHILDREN ACT."

WHEREAS, this Republic Act is intended to prevent acts of violence against women or her child and further designed to stop the perpetrator from committing or threatening further physical harm on the victim;

WHEREAS, this Republic Act gives them immunity from lawsuits for breaking into a house to stop an incident of domestic abuse;


WHEREAS, Barangay Officials are the nearest people that victims of domestic abuse can run for help.
