RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2964**, S-2005

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE, MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT GUTTED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OCCUPIED BY MORE OR LESS ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE (125) FAMILIES AT MARIA CLARA STREET CORNER ARANETA AVENUE, TIRAD PASS, BARANGAY STO. DOMINGO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, ON NOVEMBER 16, 2004.

Introduced by Councilors JOSEPH P. JUICO, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., FRANCISCO A. CALALAY, JR. and ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS.

WHEREAS, a portion of Maria Clara Street corner Araneta Avenue, Tirad Pass, Barangay Sto. Domingo, District I, Quezon City was gutted by fire on November 16, 2004, which razed the houses occupied by more or less One Hundred Twenty-Five (125) families;

WHEREAS, the affected families are experiencing financial difficulties resulting from the calamity and are now in dire need of financial assistance from the City government;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Section 458 (a)(1)(iv) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as "Local Government Code of 1991", the Sangguniang Panlungsod is empowered to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said events";

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod may provide assistance in the form of cash which shall be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City government or from any available source of fund thereof.



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable, Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to extend financial assistance in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer, to the victims of the fire that gutted the residential houses occupied by more or less One Hundred Twenty-Five (125) families at Maria Clara Street corner Araneta Avenue, Tirad Pass, Barangay Sto. Domingo, District I, Quezon City, on November 16, 2004.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) of Quezon City shall authenticate the beneficiaries of the assistance and furnish the City Councilor a copy of the same.
