RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2974**, S-2005

RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO BELMONTE, JR. TO CONSTRUCT A SCHOOL BUILDING AT DOÑA ROSARIO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PREMISES, BARANGAY NOVALICHES PROPER, QUEZON CITY, AS A REPLACEMENT OF THE OLD SCHOOL BUILDING THAT WAS RAZED BY FIRE ON APRIL 17, 2005.

WHEREAS, Art XIV Section 1 of the Constitution provides that the state shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make each education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, the old school building of Doña Rosario Elementary School was razed by fire on April 17, 2005;

WHEREAS, there is an increasing number of students enrolled at the said Elementary School;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to construct a new school building as a replacement of the school building recently razed by fire, in order to accommodate more classrooms for students.


