RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE IMMEDIATE PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL 221 ENTITLED "AN ACT GRANTING THE MAGNA CARTA FOR DAY CARE WORKERS, PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

WHEREAS, House Bill 221 entitled "An act granting the Magna Carta for Day Care workers, providing funds therefor, and for other purposes" authored by Rep. Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, is seeking to promote and improve the social and economic status of day care workers;

WHEREAS, there is a big load of responsibility in childhood development that falls on the shoulders of Day Care Workers, the moment children are left in their care;

WHEREAS, they are considered as "partners" of many parents in providing early education to our children, and they are the most hardworking and committed service providers to our pre-school children;

WHEREAS, sad to say there is no law that protects the interest of one of our most important service provider;


WHEREAS, Day Care Workers are only receiving a meager monthly allowance of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) as provided for by Republic Act 6972 or Day Care Law, a measure that rationalized the establishment of Day Care Centers in every Barangay.
