A RESOLUTION URGING ALL NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICES ALL WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY TO PROVIDE A COURTESY LANE THAT WILL CATER EXCLUSIVELY TO ALL SENIOR CITIZENS, PREGNANT WOMEN, HANDICAPPED AND GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the handicapped, due to their physical infirmities and/or deformities, the elderly, pregnant women and government officials must be given distinct and separate lanes to prevent inconvenience on their part whenever they transact business in the respective offices mentioned above;

WHEREAS, by providing a separate lane for such elderly, handicapped, pregnant women and government officials in the aforesaid establishments and offices, the latter offices and establishments will be able to address efficiently and effectively the specific needs and at the same time provide an environment that will provide satisfaction and contentment;

WHEREAS, at present, it cannot be denied that not all National Government Offices and the Quezon City Government Offices all within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City have their own "Courtesy Lane" that cater solely and exclusively to elderly, pregnant women, handicapped and government officials relative to their basic queries,


