RESOLUTION NO. SP-3064 (PR2005-225), S-2005

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND EXCELLENT BUILDING CARE AND GENERAL SERVICES, INC. TO PROVIDE CLEANING MAINTENANCE, SANITATION AND JANITORIAL SERVICES COVERING PERIOD JANUARY 1 TO JUNE 30, 2005.
