A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE PRESIDENT GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, THRU THE HOME **GUARANTY** CORPORATION (HGC) TO SUSPEND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DEMOLITION OF THIRTY-SEVEN (37)STRUCTURES SITUATED AΤ RIVERSIDE UNIT III, BARANGAY COMMONWEALTH, QUEZON CITY WHICH ARE AFFECTED BY THE ECONOMIC CONTROLLED ZONE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the National Government Center (NGC) has established the Economic Controlled Program of the government, designated at 100 meters from the gutter of Commonwealth Avenue, inward and westward from BF Homes Road to Don Jose Junction before the gate of Fairview Subdivision;

WHEREAS, the area covered by this program, are filled-up with structures and residential houses of urban poor families and numerous demolitions were undertaken and were relocated at Montalban, Rizal;

WHEREAS, to date, there are still about thirty seven (37) remaining structures left to be demolished unless remedial measures be undertaken.
