A RESOLUTION MANDATING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS) TO CONTINUE AND PROCEED WITH THE ACCREDITATION OF TOWING SERVICES IN QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RULES AND REGULATION.

Introduced by Councilors ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, EDCEL B. LAGMAN, JR., ALMA F. MONTILLA, RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN and BAYANI V. HIPOL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines and procedures for towing operation of all private and government towing company/agencies under the Traffic Management Code of Quezon City which shall be monitor by the City government;

WHEREAS, under Traffic Management Code of Quezon City, all towing company/agencies shall secure accreditation/authority before they can operate the towing service otherwise towing incident shall be considered an unlawful act;

WHEREAS, traffic is known to be one of the cancers of a growing city specially in Quezon City and one cause of this problem are the illegally parked vehicles in some busy streets and thoroughfares;

WHEREAS, the City and National government have limited manpower and facilities to reduce this problem;

WHEREAS, there are some private towing companies who offer their services to help the government to work out for the removal of roadside and sidewalk obstructions brought about by illegally parked vehicles and stalled vehicles;


WHEREAS, the approval of the operation of this private towing company is imperative to prevent or reduce prevailing traffic problem in Quezon City.
