WHEREAS, it is of public knowledge that in highly urbanized city like Quezon City, crimes are a common nightmares which endangers lives of the citizenry;


WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for the said establishment in order to enhance police visibility not only within the area but also to the Quezon City as a whole.
