A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING GOVERNMENT'S DRIVE OF PHASING-OUT OLD BUSES AS PART OF ROAD SAFETY POLICY AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE CLEAN AIR ACT.

WHEREAS, the government has taken steps to get its phase-out program for fifteen (15) year old public utility buses (PUBs) as part of its road safety policy and in compliance with the Clean Air Act,

WHEREAS, officials of the Department of Transportation and Communication (DOTC) and Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) held meeting with PUB operators and discussed the replacement of buses manufactured more than fifteen (15) years ago;

WHEREAS, the implementation is basically to modernize and to provide safety and better services to commuters and in compliance with the Clean Air Act.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to support, as it does hereby support, government's drive to phase-out old buses as part of road safety policy and in compliance with the Clean Air Act.
